3. Resignation Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Braman and Pazzuti voting yes, none opposed to accept the resignation of Miranda Richert from the caretaker PT position at 65 Franklin St. effective May 23, 2021.
4. Appointments Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Braman and Pazzuti voting yes, none opposed to appoint Barbara O'Brien to the position of caretaker PT for 65 Franklin St. effective May 18, 2021 at a salary of \$15.71 per hour and up to 19 hours per week.

- The ramps from the skate park will be put up for auction the last week of May and the skate park will be cleaned up for the construction the 2nd week of June.

7. SCA Fiddle Paintings At this time Tracy Maybray from the Springville Center for the Arts (SCA) addressed the Mayor and Board. Ms. Maybray expressed that it is the desire of the SCA to paint more fiddles on the sidewalks in Fiddlers Green Park, Franklin St., Mechanic St. as well as on Factory Street. The proposed paintings would be similar to the current fiddles that were painted in 2019 but adding color as well as some musical notes. They would be painted in the end of June before Fiddlefest and supplies will be paid for by the Fiddlefest Committee. The project has already been presented to and approved by the Historic Preservation Commission as well as the Village Arts Committee. After Ms. Maybray's presentation motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Braman and Pazzuti voting yes, none opposed to approving the fiddle painting project as presented.
8. Concord IDA At this time Mayor Krebs discussed the Concord IDA. Mayor Krebs announced that New York State revoked the Concord IDA in 2019 and our area is now serviced by the Erie County IDA.
9. UB School Of Architecture Mayor Krebs took this opportunity to discuss the recent project of several University of Buffalo School of Architecture students. There project is now finished and he is awaiting a copy of their final presentation.
